The Point:

When things go wrong on that scenic back road, who does 911 send? Last August, a fellow we were riding with got himself in a tight spot and his bike went out from under him. 50 yards and one dented sign post later, he came to rest on the side of Highway 101. While we were trying to keep him from moving too much and making things worse for himself, a volunteer EMT with Clallam County's Hospital District #1 showed up and started rendering aid. The EMT established that he had the use of his extremities and that his head injuries were not of the amnesia or coma inducing variety. When the ambulance got there to transport him to the Community Hospital in Forks, the volunteer went on her way.

We never got the chance to thank her.

Emergency medical services in the more rural parts of the U.S. are staffed by volunteers. When you call 911 in the middle of nowhere, the volunteer responder shows up in their own car and uses equipment either purchased out of pocket or provided by a county with a very limited emergency services budget. The trauma kits used can cost as much as \$300, a hefty chunk of change for someone who has also paid for their own training and is volunteering to scrape our sorry asses off the highway when we go down.

We wanna help.

The Plan:

So, it's a Poker Run. Which means the following: **Established Motorcycle Clubs and Riding Clubs**, register as a group, designating a road captain who will get briefed on the route and lead your group. **Not in a club?** Get a posse together and fake it, give yourselves a name, designate a captain, and register as a group. **Ride solo?** Register anyway, each Pleasure Baron will lead a pack of the unaffiliated through the route.

Saturday, August 8, high noon, we'll meet up at the Shanty Tavern-9002 Lake City Way NE, for signing in, packet pickups, and a ride briefing, then we'll ride 'round lake Washington and draw a card at each of the five stops. The person at the end of the run with the best poker hand wins! Fabulous prizes, the adoration of hot babes, fame, all that good stuff.

Don't ride? Volunteer! Help us run the stops, herd bikers, or just gather at the Shanty in the evening to welcome the riders back from their adventure. Then get down with the music, drinks, and hijinks in the tavern.

Detail things: Registration \$15 per hand (yes, you can buy in more than once). Winners receive prizes donated by our sponsors. Poker is standard 5 card. Afterparty at the Shanty is 21 & over.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the entry donation, by signing this Release:

1. I agree to release, hold harmless and indemnify the Pleasure Barons Motorcycle Club (PBMC) including all its agents, sponsors, members, volunteers, employees, officers, family member, or kin, or relation of any agent, sponsor, member, volunteer, employee, or officer, and any country, state, county, city, township, or municipality through which this event may pass, from any damages arising from participation in this event including, but not limited to, physical injury, nonphysical injury, death, economic or noneconomic loss, or damage suffered during participation in this event or any activity associated with it. Additionally, I release, hold harmless and indemnify the PBMC including physical or nonphysical injury, death, economic or noneconomic loss, or damages suffered by the negligence of any party that may or may not be affiliated with the PBMC.
2. I understand that there are certain risks inherent and associated with motorcycle riding, including the significant risk of personal injury or death; I expressly assume said risks of my own free will. I further warrant that I am in proper physical condition to operate a motorcycle that meets the equipment requirements stated in RCW 46.37.530 and meet any and all licensing requirements set forth by the State of Washington regarding operation of motorcycles on public streets and highways, without restriction, and hold the PBMC harmless for any injury, loss, or offense arising from: a) failure to operate my motorcycle properly; b) lack of proper and required equipment; c) licensing non-compliance with Washington state law.
3. I understand that RCW 46.37.530 requires the use of a helmet during the operation of a motorcycle on public streets and highways in the State of Washington, and that the PBMC requires use of a helmet in compliance with said section. By signing this Release I acknowledge it is my sole responsibility to use equipment that meets these standards at all times when operating my motorcycle during this event.
4. I understand that my registration and rider number are not transferable and I agree to release, hold harmless and indemnify the PBMC for any liability resulting from injury, loss, or damage suffered as a result of the participation of the individual using my registration or rider number, with or without my consent. Therefore, I understand that any cost, debt, fine, loss, or expense incurred by the PBMC resultant from conduct by any individual (including myself) using my registration and rider number shall be remitted in full to the PBMC by me.
5. I give permission to the PBMC to use my image as it appears in any photos or video taken in this event for future publication used to promote the PBMC, this event, or other events, at the sole discretion of the PBMC. The PBMC shall not publish pictures containing

- any potentially offensive or degrading material. I understand that photos or video taken by any participant that is not a member of the PBMC are not the responsibility of the PBMC, and by signing this Release I expressly release, hold harmless and indemnify the PBMC from any loss, libel, defamation, or criminal prosecution resultant from dissemination of said images.
6. I state that I am the legal parent or legal guardian for the participant under 18 years of age listed on this Release and accept sole responsibility for this person's well being and compliance with all rules of this event.
7. I understand that this Release is also binding on my heirs, agents, representatives, and any participant under 18 years of age for which I am the legal guardian. I further agree to release, hold harmless and indemnify the PBMC from any claims brought on behalf of, or any physical or nonphysical injury, death, economic or noneconomic loss, or damages caused by or incurred by the participant under 18 years of age for whom I am the legal guardian.
8. I acknowledge and accept that the PBMC reserves the right to remove any participating rider, including myself, from participation this event, with or without cause, solely at the discretion of any PBMC member or designated ride group leader. Removal from the event does not entitle the ejected participant to any refund of the entry donation.
9. I accept that, if there is an incident that causes the suspension of the event, entry donations will be retained by the PBMC and the club will reschedule the event for the earliest possible date within 90 days of the original scheduled event. At that time, should it become evident that a rescheduled date is not reasonably attainable, the PBMC will issue a refund for the entry donation, provided such request for refund is received by the PBMC in writing.
10. I understand and agree that any litigation arising from my voluntary participation in this event shall be filed and adjudicated in the State of Washington, in accordance with all applicable titles, chapters, and sections of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) and Washington Administrative Code (WAC) enacted and relevant at the date of this Release, without exception.
11. I accept and agree to abide by the rules of the event so as to ensure the enjoyment of the event by all participants, sponsors, vendors, and volunteers to ensure the maximum benefit of the organization chosen as the recipient of the proceeds of this event.

I REPRESENT THAT I HAVE MADE FULL DISCLOSURE AND HAVE READ, UNDERSTAND, AND ACCEPT THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS STATED IN THIS AGREEMENT, AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE EFFECTIVE AND BINDING ON ALL PARTIES.
